

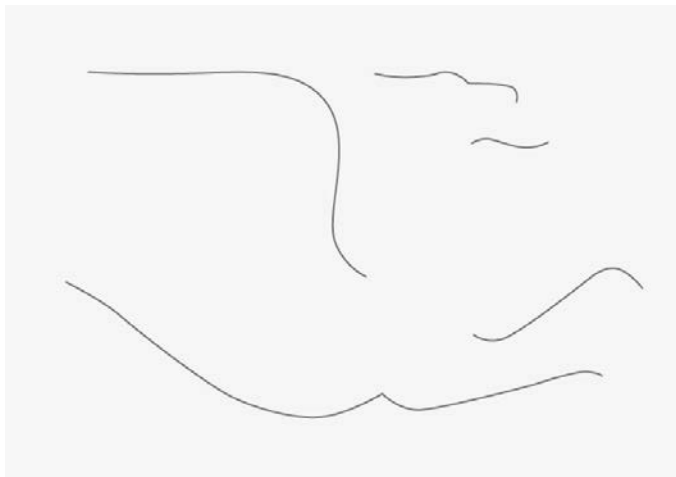
# #InspiredByProMarker drawing challenge

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The #InspiredByProMarker drawing challenge is operated by ColArt International Holdings Ltd ("ColArt"), The Studio Building, 21 Evesham Street, London, W11 4AJ, England.

### THE CHALLENGE

- Create a piece of work with ProMarkers and/or BrushMarkers that starts off from a provided set of lines
- In order to be eligible to win, entries will need to include the lines below from the #InspiredByProMarker drawing challenge template, available to download from winsornewton.com



- Entries must be primarily made with Winsor & Newton ProMarkers and /or BrushMarkers, as determined by ColArt in its discretion. However, it is allowed to use fine liners, pencils etc. for line art, shading and embellishment of the work
- ColArt retains the right to refuse works that do not conform to these terms and conditions
- Works must be 2-dimensional and in landscape format
- Works must be created in one of the following sizes: A4, A3, 9"x12" or 11"x14"

### PRIZES

- The winner will receive a full set of ProMarkers (148 colours) as well as a full set of BrushMarkers (72 colours)
- The runner up will receive a full set of ProMarkers
- The second runner up will receive a full set of BrushMarkers
- The public favourite, which will be the entry with the most likes, will receive a full set of ProMarkers

### HOW TO ENTER

- You can enter the challenge by posting an image of your work on Instagram
- Please use the following two hashtags when submitting your work: #InspiredByProMarker and #WinsorNewtonChallenge
- Submission deadline is 31 October 2016 23.59 GMT
- No hard copy applications will be accepted, nor entries submitted on Facebook, Twitter or any other platform other than Instagram

### YOUR CREATION

- The work must be entirely the entrant's original idea and creation and it must not infringe someone else's copyright or other intellectual property rights
- The work must be lawful. It must not be offensive, obscene, racist, insulting, discriminating or otherwise objectionable and it must not contain any form of advertising
- The number of entries per person is unlimited
- By submitting an application, the entrant promises that all of the information in the application is correct
- ColArt is not responsible if applications are not received for whatever reason

### WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

- The competition is open to any artist over the age of 15
- Employees (and their families) of ColArt and anyone connected with the competition are not eligible

### INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- Entrants retain ownership of copyright of their submissions
- Should ColArt wish to use entrant's drawing for marketing purposes, ColArt will first need to obtain written permission from the artist in order to do so

### GENERAL

- If ColArt is unable to contact any winner within 3 weeks of announcing the winners, the prize lapses and ColArt reserves the right to select alternative winners in its discretion
- The entrant promises to comply with these terms and conditions and any other competition requirements specified by ColArt (whether on its website or otherwise) and ColArt reserves the right to exclude any entry which in its opinion does not comply
- The entrant will be liable for any reasonably foreseeable loss or damage suffered by ColArt arising from the artist's breach of this agreement
- In all matters arising in connection with the competition, ColArt's decision shall be final
- ColArt reserves the right to cancel this competition or alter these terms and conditions if it considers that it has good reason to do so
- These terms and conditions are governed by English law and any disputes will be decided only by the courts of the United Kingdom
